# INTERNATIONAL YEAR ONE

This programme is equivalent to the first year of an undergraduate degree.

As part of the International Year One, you will study in university-style classes and learn with a combination of classroom teaching, small group tuition and personal tutorial sessions with lecture-style classes and you will progress to Year 2 of your undergraduate degree.

This programme is designed to significantly improve your academic language skills, including critical thinking and academic writing, whilst allowing you the additional classroom support you need from our qualified teachers.



# PRE-MASTER'S PROGRAMME

This programme is designed to prepare you for your studies by allowing you to practise your academic skills in a supportive environment.

Though you may have experience of studying at undergraduate level in another country, the expectations of postgraduate study can be very different in the UK.





## Williamson Park

Through fine art collections and exhibits, the Lancaster City Museum provides insight into the people who have made Lancaster what it is today.




## Highest Point Festival

# ACCOMMODATION

Where you live is an important part of your university experience. Lancaster is a vibrant university city offering all the benefits of a great student life experience within a small and welcoming community.

The university provides a range of campus accommodation to cater for all budgets, offering excellent value for money. It provides a safe environment for you to live, study and socialise. Accommodation options include standard single and en-suite with pricing starting from £103 per week.



## WADDELL HALLS\*

Situated on campus, Waddell Halls ensure convenient access to lectures and seminars while offering a peaceful retreat from the main campus bustle. The centre of Lancaster is just a 10-minute walk away.

Waddell Halls offer a total of 241 rooms, including 227 standard single bedrooms and 16 ensuite options. Each flat accommodates between 6 to 7 students, providing a comfortable living environment with shared facilities.

### Features:

- Events organised by the Residence Life Assistant for both on- and off-campus activities
- Open-plan kitchen and dining area, complete with a communal lounge and shared bathrooms
- Adapted rooms available for students with mobility or hearing impairments
- On-site bike storage and included contents insurance
- Laundry facilities
- Wi-Fi

## SHARED HOUSE

For students who do not wish to live at Cumbria’s Lancaster campus, there are affordable house share options in Lancaster to choose from.

### COULSTON ROAD, LANCASTER

Distance to campus: 12-minute walk

# NEXT STEPS

## 1. APPLICATION:

Submit your application online: [internationalcollege.cumbria.ac.uk/apply](https://internationalcollege.cumbria.ac.uk/apply) or scan the QR code below



Our team will contact you to submit your supporting documents:

- A copy of your passport
- A copy of your academic transcript and certificate
- Proof of your English language level (UKVI IELTS or equivalent)
- A Personal Statement

Additional documentation may be required depending on your application. If our team need more information, we will let you know.

## 2. ADMISSIONS ASSESSMENT:

Our Admissions team will review your application and documents. Some students may be called for pre-screening so keep an eye out for a call from us.

## 3. OFFER LETTER:

We will send you an offer letter. It may be conditional, and we'll let you know what we will need from you, or it will be unconditional.

If we think the course is not right for you, we will suggest an alternative.

## 4. ACCEPT YOUR OFFER:

To hold your place on the course, you will need to meet all the remaining conditions. We can only confirm your place once all conditions have been met and the deposit paid. Please note that if you require a visa to study with us, you may need to provide additional evidence to comply with the visa regulations in the UK. You may also need to pass a credibility interview. We'll let you know more about how to prepare.

## 5. CAS ISSUED:

Once you have paid your remaining fees, met all the conditions of offer, and passed a credibility interview if required, we will confirm your place and send you a Confirmation of Acceptance for Studies (CAS). You will need this to obtain a visa. Please note a CAS can only be issued up to six months before the start of the course (if you apply from outside the UK) or up to three months (if you are eligible to apply from within the UK).

## 6. APPLY FOR VISA:

You will then need to apply for your visa. It is your responsibility to obtain a visa before you travel to join the course. If you do not have a valid visa for studies in the UK, you will not be able to join the course.

## 7. ARRIVAL:

You should arrive on the weekend before the start date of the course. Please tell us when you are coming. We will send you pre-arrival information about your course and life in the UK.

We look forward to welcoming you.


